Thank you to 5S for their fantastic assembly this week; the children performed very well, sharing their learning with us all. We are very proud of them.



## **Online Safety**

There is a new app called 'Dumbsmash' which is a video messaging app where people can upload themselves singing over famous songs and then choose to share them. It is not intended for children under 18. However there are some primary school children utilising this app. Within the Q&A section of the app there is a question posed by someone asking whether or not they should upgrade to 'Dumbsmash 2'. It says: 'Dumbsmash 2' has nothing to do with 'Dumbsmash' but it a malware app that hides itself on phones and then pushes users to inappropriate content. As soon as it is set up, the icon deletes itself and runs in the background without the user's knowledge.

**Musical.ly**- allows users to post videos. Viewers can leave unfiltered feedback on the site.
